

The Project Partners:



The municipal utility Khersonvodokanal, based in Kherson, Ukraine, is the primary water service provider for more than **300,000** people in the greater Kherson region. Established **136 years ago**, the company is responsible for water supply and wastewater drainage services. Khersonvodokanal operates a **929-kilometre-long** water supply network, approximately **55 %** of which consists of outdated infrastructure.

BonnNetz is the municipal water and energy network operator for the city of Bonn and responsible for the supply of approximately **330,000** residents with electricity, gas, water, and district heating. BonnNetz operates a drinking water network of around **980 kilometres** with more than **56,000** connections and is also responsible for managing parts of the communication and data network, as well as the public street lighting infrastructure, across the Bonn region.

Key Milestones in the Partnership:

- First successful procurement and delivery to Kherson in June 2024 of urgently needed aid supplies to restore the drinking water supply
- Personal visit by representatives of Khersonvodokanal to Bonn in October 2025
- Procurement and delivery of 4 pressure boosting systems to Kherson to supply 4 high-rise buildings in December 2025
- Regular professional and friendly exchange
